Devils Lake Aquatic Vegetation Management

DLWID is currently monitoring the Parrot Feather growth in the lake. Once the growth reaches an active state the vegetation management contractor will be contacted for scheduling the treatment. Currently the volume of Parrot Feather appears low or not present in most areas of the lake. Social media posts have been issued informing lakefront residents of the best practices for removing weeds from around their private in-water structures.

Water Quality Briefing

Continued very high clarity in most parts of Devils Lake with visibility beyond 15' in some areas. We continue to see positive dissolved oxygen trends on the lake bottom of more than 98% saturation. Some minor algae growth is present but does not appear problematic at this time. Water temps are warm at over 71 degrees f, Ph average is 7.4, and I am seeing far more fish in the lake this year.
