### **Devils Lake Conservation/Aeration Project**

Compressor is operational with no known problems. Diffuser count was full, all diffusers are present and operational. All maintenance was performed in September with no incident.

### **Devils Lake Aquatic Vegetation Management**

Milfoil management update:

No change from September 2021, Milfoil appears to be concentrated in the canals near the D River

A summary of last years treatment is posted on www.dlwid.org as well as our social media outlets

SePro has been contacted several times and has not provided a scheduled date to perform the in-water work. DLWID is currently interviewing other vegetation management providers to work with regarding the upcoming need for submerged aquatic vegetation control in Devils Lake.

DLWID staff is also reviewing costs associated with multiple SAV management options. Staff plans to submit a grant request to the Oregon Department of Agriculture for funding assistance with our ongoing invasive species management efforts.

### **Water Quality Briefing**

A slight increase in Dissolved Oxygen on the lake bottom was noted during sampling between September and

October. Dissolved Oxygen levels are very healthy at over 99% on the lake bottom lake wide with very little visible algae at this time. E Coli sampling for 2021 is complete with all results well below the low-risk threshold.
