# **District Projects and Operations**

### **Communications Report**

A press release regarding the progress of vegetation management efforts in Devils Lake has been drafted and released to the media. The focus of the press release is the grass carp re-stocking efforts.

### **Devils Lake Conservation/Aeration Project**

All equipment is fully operational and maintained per schedule.

### **Devils Lake Aquatic Vegetation Management**

Pilot Herbicide treatments for nuisance submerged aquatic vegetation began 6-13-2022. Staff
continues monitoring any changes in water quality and vegetation density. To date the treated areas,
particularly, the marina is showing a reduction in plant mass in the water. This could be seasonal
changes of the plant life cycle.



- 2. District staff continue to work with the ODFW to finalize the number of grass carp to be introduced for the initial stocking. Once finalized the information will be reflected in the final permit application. The ODFW commission anticipates the permit to be presented to them at their January meeting.
- 3. The Devils Lake Neighborhood Association continues to work with lake residents on solutions to maintain in-water lakefront property and structures. Updates can be viewed @ https://www.dlakeoregon.com/.

### **Devils Lake Flood Protection**

A planning meeting between District Staff, Civil West, and Campbell Environmental took place this week. The permit is mostly complete. Next steps will be to obtain signatures from the 4 involved property owners prior to submittal of the Joint Permit Application (JPA).

### Water Quality Briefing

- Due to unusually high levels of visible algae the lake was sampled and tested for toxic algae last week.
  Results were received from OHA earlier this week and did NOT indicate any detectable toxic algae
  constituents.
- 2. For the first time since its installation, depressed oxygen levels have been observed at the southernmost sample point. The level was approximately 1 mg/l. Healthy 02 levels for fish and wildlife range from 3-5 mg/L.
- 3. The D River has once again been issued a recreational advisory due to high levels of fecal coliform. Testing in the lake itself continues to show record low detections of E coli. The E.coli sampling season for 2022 has concluded.
