

Each week during the recreation season the Devils Lake Water Improvement District tests and monitors the waters of Devils Lake for E. coli and Harmful Algal Blooms. DLWID staff conducts weekly samplings to keep residents and users of the lake informed.

It is important to keep in mind that E. coli is a natural part of the lake system. Humans have naturally occurring E. coli bacteria in their intestines, but people and animals alike can become infected with the strand of E. coli 0157:H7 that commonly occurs in undercooked foods, contaminated water, and feces. This data is informational only and does not indicate a closure or an actual advisory but is posted here to serve as a guide to water quality in and around Devils Lake.
